GreenWood Resources Europe's Overview

- GWR Europe is focusing on developing businesses in Europe through the establishment of long-term wood supply agreements (WSA) based predominantly on the use of short-rotation crops, such as poplar and eucalyptus;
- Target end products are pulp fiber, biomass, veneer for plywood and oriented strand board fiber;
- Current target countries are Poland, Romania and Spain;
- GWR Europe currently has operations in Poland (over 6000 ha under management) and Romania (580 ha)



Tree species: hybrid poplar, mainly Deltoides x Nigra (DxN)

Planting stock:

- 175 cm long rods
- 80 cm long rods

Density: 1100 to 1650 trees/ha

Planting period: March through May

Harvest rotation: 5 to 6 years

Genetic material: poplar clones developed by Alasia Franco Vivai (Savigliano-Italy) are currently deployed in GWR managed plantations. GWR's proprietary clones were recently imported to Europe and are being field tested in Romania and Poland

Silvicultural and Operational Activities:

- Acquisition analysis of land-suitability and site class evaluation;
- Site and soil-preparation activities;
- Planting operations;
- Crop-care activities (mechanical and chemical weed control, pest control, fertilization, singling, etc.);
- Infrastructure development and maintenance (roads, canals, fence, etc.);
- Periodic growth and development inventory.

Operators: All field work and equipment operation is performed by third-party contractors

Management and Oversight: In-field activities managed by GWR Tree Farm Technicians and overseen by Operations Manager
